a ship called the Burgh of Stand which stode within
the Dominion of his Majesty of Sweden, wherof
saide saunders is Comm^o: and also that the said commander
and seamen are all subjects of his said Majesty of Sweden
and also that the said ship, hath broken bulke by landing
