Majesty of Sweden and the Town of Hano alias Hooe
and all clearly satisfied that the said Sandor Sanders and
all the Seaman belonging to the said Ship and natural
born Subjects of his majesty of Sweden and
Sandor Sanders in open court confessed that the
said Brigands were made at Hano alias Hooe aforesaid and
were by him taken in and loaded on board the said Ship
and the said Sandor Sanders now his attorney Thomas
Holley aforesaid having nothing to alledge in justification
of the said Ship but the masters pronounced against
the act of Parliament aforesaid put the said information
mentioned this Court is all clearly satisfied that the said
Ship is condemned to gather with all her guns tackle
furniture ammunition and apparel and so adjudged that
the said Ship called the Burgh of Hano alias Hooe
to gather with all her guns tackle furniture ammunition
and apparel to be condemned for the breach of the act
of parliament aforesaid according to the tenour and
form in the said act of parliament set forth and provided
that is to say one third to his majesty Charles the Second
that now as King of England &c one other third part
to his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq^r Capt^r general
and Chief gouernour of this province and the
Remaining third part to the said Benjamin Cooper
as informer due to him for informing and suiting
for the same as aforesaid.

And the court being commanded by their Commissioners
if the said Ship should be condemned to order and appoint
two honest understanding men to appraise the said Ship
to gather with all her guns tackle furniture ammunition
and apparel upon their oaths the court did appoint
George Roger mate of the ship Proprietary of London, and —
