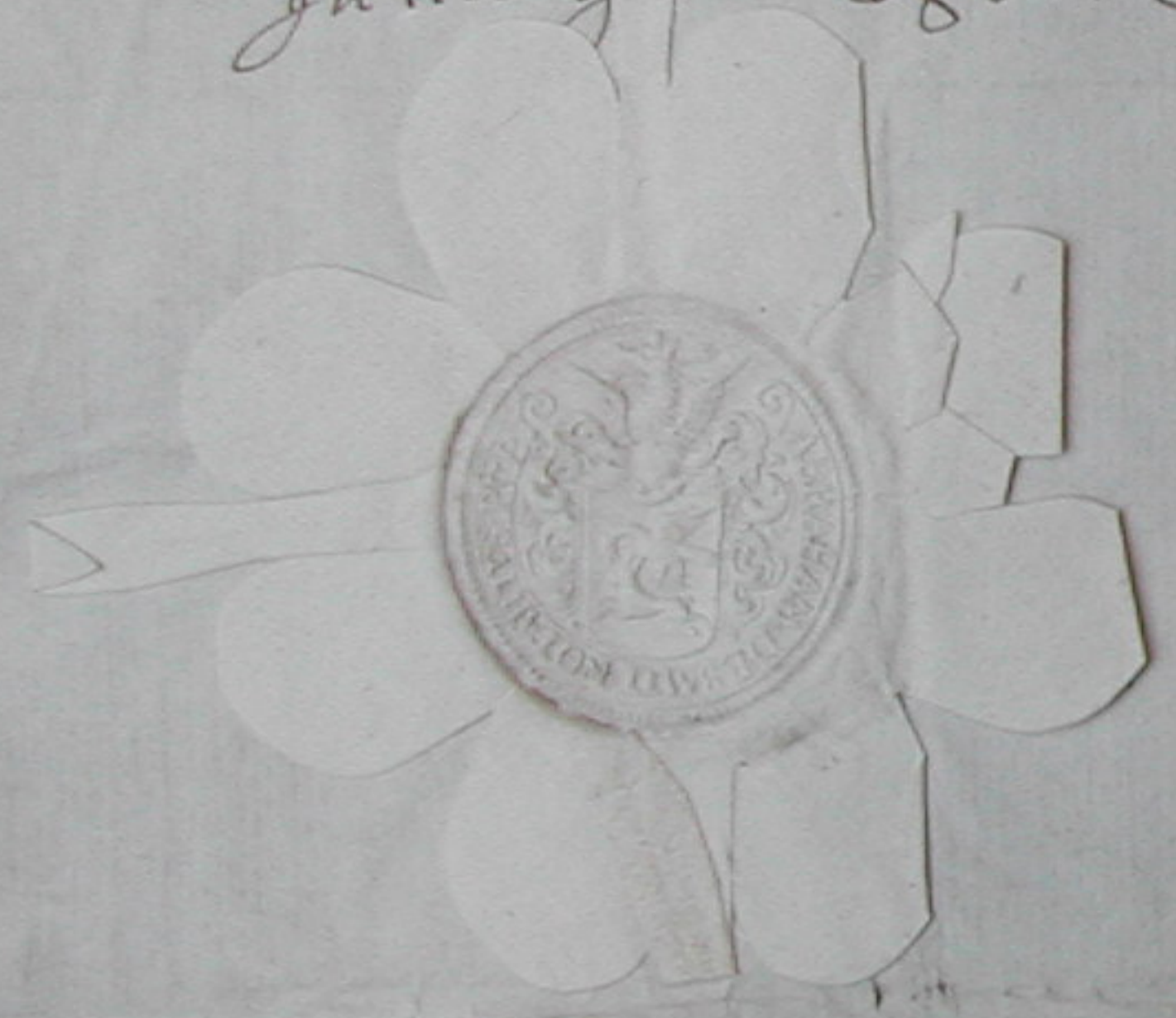


Hanson being Mariners and Sailors belonging to, and sailing the said Ship and now being desirous

 I do hereby give licence to the said George Edgar to transport and carry thither the said
 Sander Sanders John Corneliffon Claus Jacobson Jacob Peterson Laurdred Jansen Jurian
 Clauison Swann Anderson Claus Peterson George Kolderton Peter holder Alexander Mannings
 Sander Sanderfon Jacob Kolsso and Christian Hanson, in the said Ship called the Golden
 flow of Maryland to the said Port of Newcastle as passengers in the said Ship and not
 otherwise Given Under my hand lesse Seale of this Province the ninth day of Augy
 in the 11th year of our Lord 1673
