Don't Let The Bosses Smoke-Screen The Issues---This Is A Campaign Of "Principles" Not "Personalities"

and real principles are at stake, a few individuals find themselves unable (or perhaps unwilling) to differentiate between "personalities" and

For this reason it is, perhaps, well to explain in clear and simple language that The Fighting Tribune's campaign to restore the government of Dorchester County to the people and take it out of the hands of a Political Machine is a campaign involving vital American principels, and not one of petty personalities. The fight against Boss Har-

rington, therefore, is not one of personalities but principles. As political boss of Dorchester County; as the self-established head of the Democratic party, as a handpicker of tickets and as an exponent of the theory that only a little coterie of select political friends should enjoy the honors and pecuniary benefits of public office, we oppose him and his methods with all the vigor at our command.

Dealing in personalities is not the business of a newspaper that is honestly and sincerely interested in the public welfare. But the matter of principles, affecting the best interests of our citizens, our county and our city, are matters which do and should very seriously concern any newspaper that has given its pledge to the people that it will work for them and serve them-fearlessly and courage-

Therefore we have no hesitancy whatever in saying that Boss Harrington's control of the governmental machinery of this county and that his control of the Democratic party in this county has seldom been used for any purpose other than to create personal benefits for himself and an intimate coterie of sub-bosses. His has never been a type of constructive leadership to contribute substantially to the welfare, progress or the improvement of mankind in his native county.

To the contrary, the records show that his stewardship is one that is freely marked by the most selfish domination and that year after year through his law firm and through his ferry holdings he has reaped rich benefits in colossal sums of money from the public treasury of Dorchester County and the public treasury of the State of Maryland.

We do NOT regard this as constructive statesmanship.

We DO regard it as selfish political bossism.

We also believe that Dorchester County, as never before, reeds men with vision and courage to make this a greater, more prosperous and more forwarding looking community.

We do not believe that this can be accomplished under continued machine rule And we do believe that our county government should be

restored to the hands of the people instead of being allowed to drift along in the clutches of professional political bosses.

We make this explanation so that all may fully understand we have no personal malice toward Boss Harrington. As above stated, our objection to him is as a Boss and as the self-appointed head of the Democratic party. The question before the electorate in the Democratic primaries on September 12 is whether or not real issues and real principles shall survive. And those who would attempt to draw a red herring across the path of the voters by calling our expressions 'personalities" will find that the voters are too intelligent and too capable of thinking for themselves to be deceived by this well-known trick which politicians have always restored to as their last line of defense.

Make no mistake about it. The people of Dorchester County understand this campaign better than any local campaign in many years. And they know that the nomination and election of the complete Anti-Harrington Ticket will smash a selfish political machine and make government by the people, for the people and with the people a reality so that it may function for the benefit of all our citizens and not for the selfish interests of a select few.
