There are two steps in controlling these pests, he said The first is to rid pets of adult fleas and the second is to treat the places where pets sleep or frequent in the home. He said that the best way to

rid pets of adult fleas was to bathe them in warm water in which had been added from two to four tablespoons of creolin The animals should be thoroughly covered with the solution if it to prove effective. Dogs should be allowed to remain wet with the solution for about fifteen minutes but should not be permitted to lick their coats Then the dogs should be washed with soap and warm water and dried thoroughly.

Cats are sensitive to creolin dips and should be washed immediately after being taken from the solution. Amos said that creosote dips could be used in place of creolin, if desired.
