Public Local Law

OPERATIVE IN KENT COUNTY.
Passed at the Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1884.

To Regulate the Catching of Fish in Chester River.

AN ACT to repeal chapter four hundred and eleven and chapter three hundred and thirty-three of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and chapter one hundred and fourteen of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, entitled "An act to better regulate the time and manner of taking and catching fish in the waters of Chester river and its tributaries..."

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to take, capture or destroy fish in the waters of Chester river or its tributaries...

SECTION 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for any person or persons who use stakes or poles in settling nets...

SECTION 3. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to use any net or trap of any kind...

SECTION 4. And be it enacted, That upon the information of any person or persons who believe that any person or persons have violated any of the provisions...

SECTION 5. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same be here repealed...
