HOSTETTER'S BITTERS. In Cochis, China, says a writer, birds are frightened away from grain fields and fruit trees, and from poultry houses, by the following device: 'Old bottles are taken, the contents are poured out, the cork is passed with its end hanging down, where a small piece of tin, flat or any other cheap material, is fastened to the neck of the bottle and the tin end makes way for the wind to be blown into the bottle. After preparing in this manner a number of bottles, these are placed in the soil, and on their top the bottles are put by a string fastened at the neck of the bottle. The arrangement then is in a position similar to a fishing rod placed in the ground, which the fish caught would be the bottle. Where there are trees the sawdust may be suspended on slender branches, sometimes one hundred or more at other times on higher ones. When used again at other times the tin end of the bottles are unlike in aim and shape to that of some of them is often a very pleasing one.'
