That "divinity which shapes our ends" brought the writer to the beautiful little city of St. Paul, the capital of the State of Minnesota, and one of the most progressive and handsome cities in the Northern States.

The limits of St. Paul embrace the head of navigation on the Mississippi river, and comprise an area of thirty square miles, including both banks of the great river.
