REPLY TO "SIMON SHARY." Messrs. Editors:—The strictures of your correspondent on my lecture on "Advanced Agriculture" delivered in Fair Hill, April 19th, of such a character as to demand a short reply, and in the interest of an inquiring public I ask for its place in the columns of your much read and highly prized paper. I am sorry to say not only that the memory of friend Simon is somewhat defective but it is somewhat prodigious as well. He does not only demand a short reply, but he also demands a very long one. How long must I write before he may be satisfied? My answer was, that unless more liberally applied in the future than in the past, such a time would probably never come, as the greater part of the fertilizer generally used was exhausted by the application of crops that followed each application. That the land did not need more fertilizer, and that the raw material supplied by the manufacturer or natural or commercial manure were consumed into the necessities of life and that the materials were not furnished in excess of the capacity of the land to appropriate, we could not maintain. I also stated that the high grade commercial manure when applied at the rate of four hundred pounds to the acre for both crop and wheat would not only give a greater crop profit after deducting cost of fertilizer, but would leave in the soil as a permanent improvement at least one half of the phosphoric acid contained in said fertilizer—so much for having an abundant supply of the elementary of plant food with every bush of the plant. If the plant roots covered the entire area lighter applications might suffice.
