Rear Admiral Stricken With Acute Indigestion.

POPULAR IN NAVAL CIRCLES

Veteran Seemed To Be In Better Health Than For Some Time-Fell Into Sleep After Attack, But Woke Up Unable to Get His Breath.

Washington.-Rear Admiral Robley D. Evans, "Fighting Bob" to an admiring nation, died suddenly Wednesday at his home in this city. Acute indigestion ended the career of one of the most popular officers of the navy.
