By day, and a red light by night are hoisted. During the display of this signal, if the indications are such that a heavy north or west wind, or from a direction between those points, is expected, then the cautionary north-west signal is hoisted, viz.: a white flag with a black centre, by day, above the red flag with a black centre, and by night, a white light above a red one.

Along the Atlantic coast the signals are the same, only the white flag with a black centre over the red flag with a black centre, by day, and a white light above a red one, at night, is a warning that the wind will blow off the shore, and are called "off shore signals."
