EARTHQUAKES in Italy, cholera in Egypt, tornadoes in the United States, inundations in Germany, famine in Russia, war in Tonquin, Madagascar, Zululana, and several South American States, make up the list of the world's horrors.

POLITICAL HISTORY.

An Account which Leads up from 1875 to the Present.

In 1875 when John Lee Carroll was nominated gross frauds were practiced. The result was a defeat at the polls, for Carroll was no more elected Governor than Hayes was President in 1876; and the wrongs and frauds perpetrated in Maryland in 1875 gave a precedent for the Republicans to steal the Presidency in 1876.

After the election it was discovered that a conspiracy had been formed and successfully carried out to elect all candidates to the Legislature favorable to the Governor, and that the origin of it was from the Bosses. Subsequent developments showed that they had the Legislature fixed, and the majority of the Board of Public Works with them.
