The following counties show a decrease in average daily attendance: Allegany, Anne Arundel, Carroll, Cecil, Dorchester, Garrett, Harford, Kent, Washington, Worcester.

In every county, with the exception of Prince George, the average attendance is more than half the average enrollment; the best attendance is in Carroll, where it is 75 per cent. of the average enrollment and 65 per cent. of the total enrollment.
