Representative Grant, of North Carolina has a most ambitious plan for Gov-

ernment co-operation in road building. He wants Congress to appropriate \$25,-000,000, which is to be used in the States which put up equal amounts. It is a plan for the Government to go in, half and half, with States, counties or civil districts on road building.

In a bill which the North Carolinian has presented in the House he provides that the Government's share be disbursed by a body of three road commissioners, under a bureau of roads, which his bill also creates. The commissioners are to receive \$4000 a year.

Not all of the \$25,000,000 is to become available at once. Only one-fifth of the sum is to be used the first year, and the same amount each year thereafter until the whole sum is expended. If the scheme works and the States and counties respond, a total of \$50,000,000 will be expended in five years for road improvements in the United States.
