----The Federal Pure Food law, mirable in its object and direct results, has some indirect results which are undesirable, and will continue to be undesirable until the Federal law is supplemented by state laws of equal stringency. The Federal law applies only to interstate trade in foods: uffs, not to what is sold wholly within the state in which it is pro duced. This, according to the Maryland Medical Journal, of which Dr. John S. Fulton is editor, "means practically no protection for Mary landers in the purchase of foods prepared by Marylanders for the local markets. In the operation of the Meat Inspection laws this limitation strictly to interstate commerce has positive disadvantages so far as many local markets are concerned." 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
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
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
