Early Training Best For School Boy Athletes Road Work Now Will Work Wonders In Preparation For

School Meet With spring just around the corner the boys are itching to get out on the lot for much needed outdoor training. With the coming of the blue birds the county athletic meet is not far behind and nothing is better for conditioning for this event than some early outdoor work. By far too many of the school athletes leave this job off until a week or two before the event/and the results are always apparent.

For those who want to know how to get in condition to be a star on the track team this spring, start off easy but start tomorrow and follow the following simple rules.

Getting the wind sound and the muscles loose is what we are to do first. Try jogging a quarter of a mile outdoors even if it is cold. Tomorrow jog half a mile; the same next day.

The first week of track practice don't try to sprint or to start quickly. The muscles are not ready. But jogging down the road a quarter or half a mile daily will do the work.

When you get warm in early spring don't sit down to rest in a cold wind for that will stiffen the muscles and may make your conditioning work all the harder. Cool off indors.

Jogging down the road gets monotonous. Get another boy to jog with you. If your legs tire, slow to a walk but keep moving. They'll soon harden. Try this jogging stunt for two weeks. This is for sprinters, distance runners, jumpers, pole vaulters, hurdlers, weight men and every man on the team. Get the legs and wind sound.
