 of the said State, in and for the City aforesaid, personally appeared James Gibson,
Age 66 Years P.O. 1353 N. Stockton Street Baltimore Md.
 in claim no 1.013.692 of Hiram Carpenter, late Co. G, 28th M.S.C. Inf
 and made oath in due form of law that I was a Member of Co. G, 28th Regt
M.S.C. Infantry. I remember Hiram Carpenter,
as being a member of the same Company and Regiment,
I know some time after the Mine Explosion,
in front of Petersburg Va. He with other men was
examined, and sent away. I cannot recall what
they called that class of men, or where they were
sent, but I know he was one of them, I do not remember
of seeing him, till after my discharge, when I met him
in Baltimore Maryland, He is now totally blind,
yet I have every reason to believe, he is the identical man,
who served in the Regiment above mentioned.
