

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

On this 15 day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the county and state aforesaid, James H. Freeman, who, being duly sworn according to law declares that he is 78 years of age, and a resident of 735 Ajax Street County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Baltimore, Md under the name of James H. Freeman on the 31 day of March, 1864 as a 1st Lt. in Co. G, 39th Regt. U. S. G. Troops
(Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore, Md on the 4 day of Dec., 1865. That he also served no other service

That he is now a pensioner. That he has heretofore applied for pension Cert No. 552047 act July 6, 1907

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of February 6, 1907 May 11, 1912

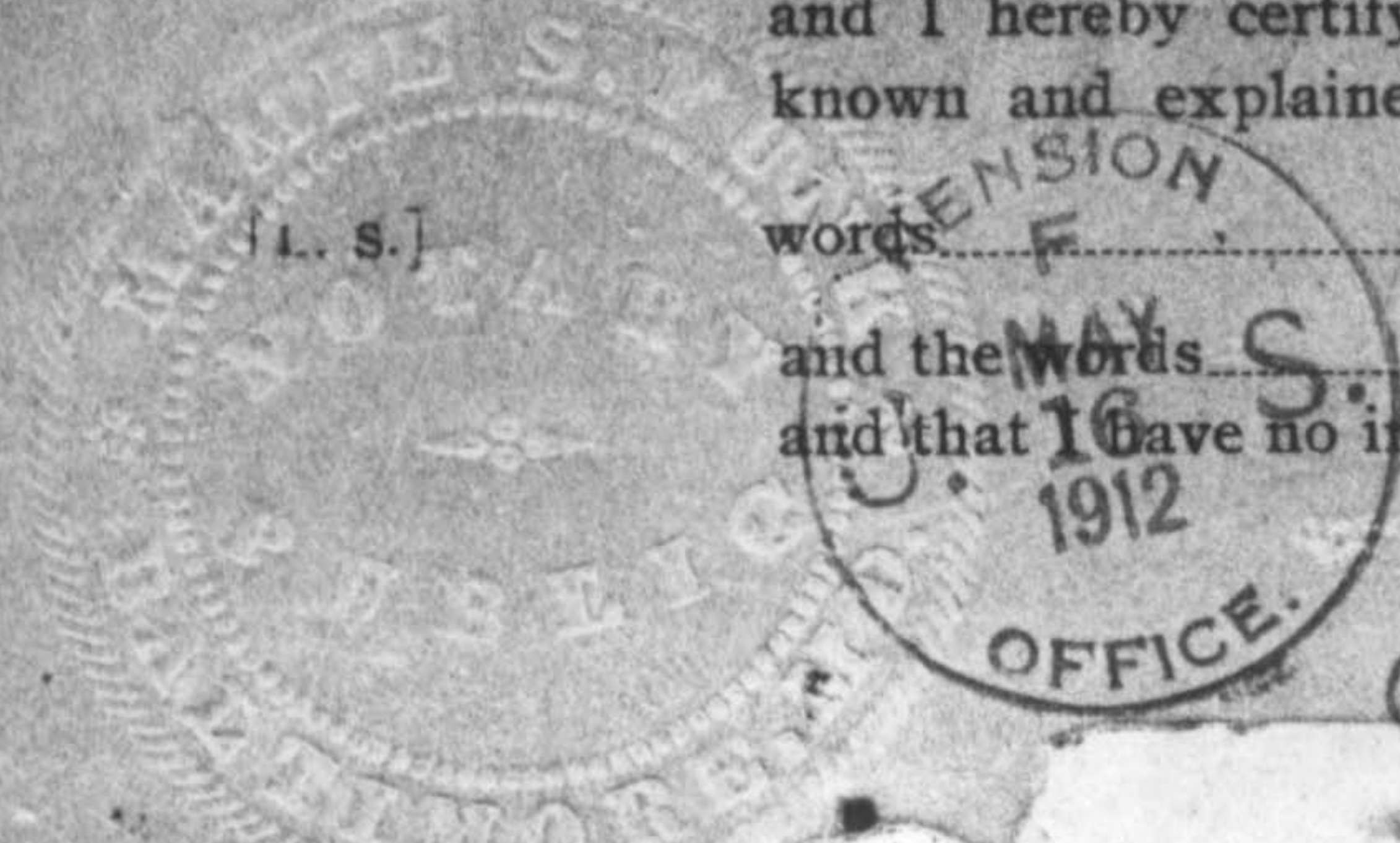
That his post-office address is 735 Ajax St county of Baltimore State of Maryland
