A more particular description of the applicant's condition is subjoined:

Height, 5.4; weight, 135; complexion, Dark Black, age, 39; pulse, 78; respiration, 20

G. S. W left arm. Superficial wound of left arm two inches above insertion of deltoid - No result, no disability. No shoulder wound. Injury to chest: Alley, that was crushed under wheels of a cannon while dismounting it; which caused hemorrhage at the time. Saps has expectorated tough yellow phlegm and has spit up blood occasionally since that time. Never had pneumonia. Parents did not die of pulmonary disease. Contour of chest natural. Some dyspnea. Natural expansion of chest limited, especially on left side; dulness on percussion over left upper lobe and absence of respiratory murmur over same space; Saps has light sweat
