It appears from the records filed in this Office, that *Wm. F. Boardley*  
*Co. "B", H. W. S. C. T.* received a Gunshot wound of side  
at the battle of New Market Heights Va. 29-30 Sept. 1864.  
Entered Fort Monro Va. Oct. 1-1864 with  
Gunshot flesh wound of right thigh, received at Deep  
Bottom Va. Sept. 29-1864 and was transferred Oct. 17/64.  
Entered De Camps G. H. David's Island N. Y. Harbor  
Oct. 18-1864 with Gunshot wound of right thigh.  
was returned to duty Dec. 2<sup>d</sup> 1864.
