State of Maryland, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner

of the United States, enrolled at the Washington, D.C. Pension Agency, at the rate

of \$36 dollars per month, Certificate No. 94255-, by reason of disability from Loss of Left Leg Here name the

That he enlisted on January 27th 1865

and was honorably discharged. That he has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than stated above.

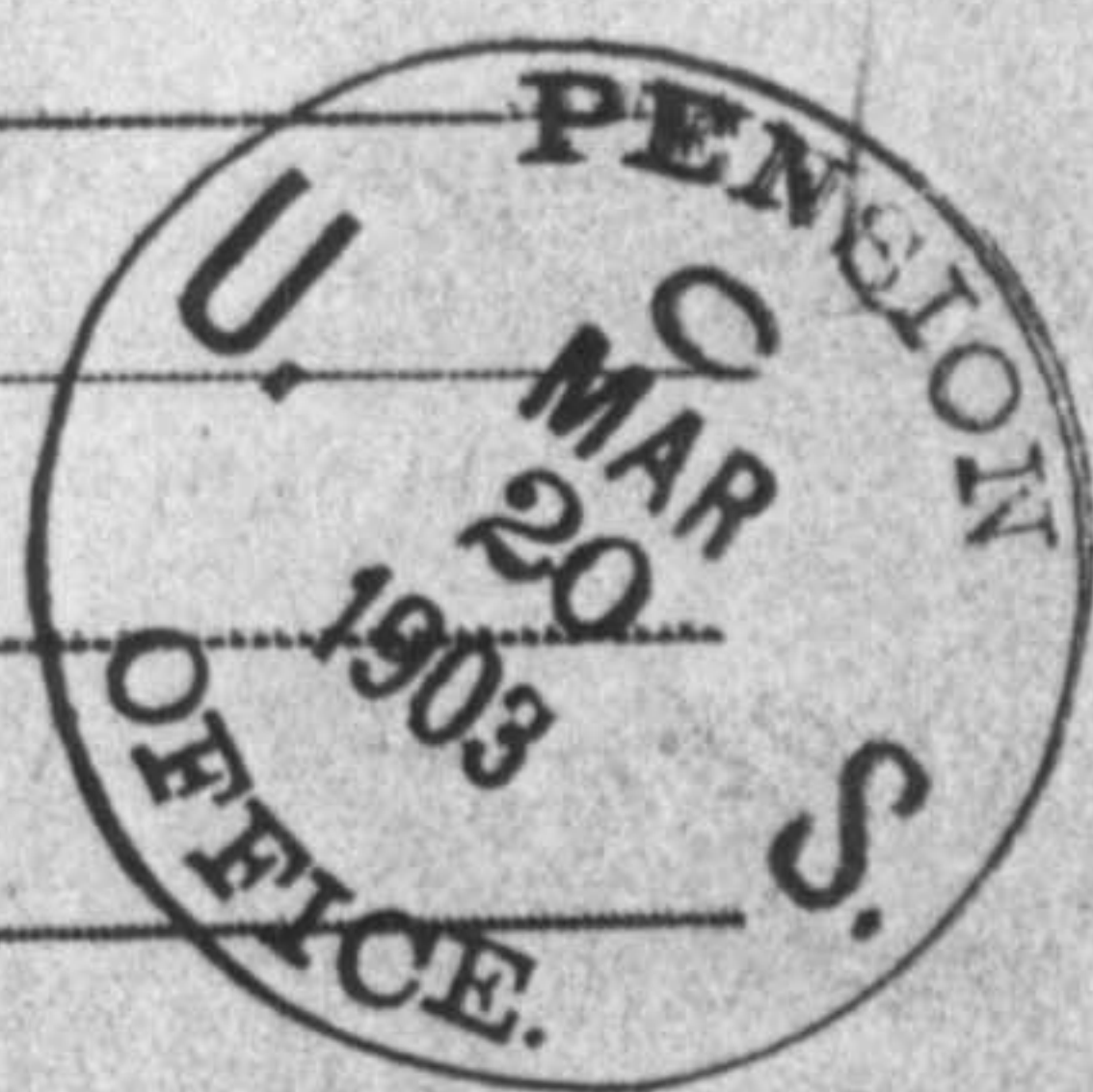
That he did not serve prior to 20th Aug 1863 nor since Jan 27th 1865

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of Provisions Here state the reasons for
