The Adj't Gen's reports that Samuel Trusty was mustered as a Private 1 September 1863, and died at Gen Hospital Newbern N.C. 30 Sept 1865. The Surgeon Gen's reports him as being died 5 October 1865, at Newbern, N.C. of bilious dysentery.

Samuel Trusty and Elizabeth Peter was married 29 May 1856, shown by testimony of witnesses who was present and evidence of cohabitation.
