

DECLARATION FOR A DISABILITY PENSION.

INVALID.

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

aged 50 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Spaac Johnson Name of Claimant. who was ENROLLED on the 26 day of Sept, 1863, in company D of the 9th regiment of U.S. 69 commanded by Col Bernuy, and was honorably DISCHARGED at 1866 on the 26 day of Sept, 1866 that his personal

description is as follows: Age 22 years; height 5 feet, 11 inches; complexion dark; hair dark eyes dark. That he is at present disabled for the performance of manual labor, in such degree as to render him unable to earn a support thereby, by reason of rupture of right side Here state name and nature of any and all disabilities, whether wound, injury or disease, which disables you for the performance of manual labor. State degree of disability.

That said disability is of a permanent character, and is not the result of vicious habits. He therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, CROSBY & DORIAN, of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorneys to prosecute his claim. That he has never received but has applied for a pension. App # 736, 573 If pension claim pending, give number of claim. If receiving pension, give number of certificate and rate of pension.
