I was a private
in Co "D" 7 Regt N.S.C. Troops. Am personally
acquainted with the claimant Nathan Johnson
I do know of my own personal knowledge that whilst
the Command was encamped at Benedict and in the
early part of 1864 whilst the claimant and others were
building log huts the said Nathan Johnson was injured
in his back, whilst disengaged. And on account of said
injury to his back the claimant was disabled
for some time how long I do not remember

I also know from my own
personal knowledge that whilst in line of duty
Nov 2d 1864 Viz Decr 1864. The claimant
and myself were taken prisoners by the enemy
Sent to Libby Prison & whilst so confined
we were compelled to work upon the enemy's roads.

we were compelled to work upon the enemy's roads
and whilst so engaged the claimant's
back gave out on account of the hard work and
on account of the injury received at Benedict Md.

since our discharge from the U.S. Service in 1866

I have seen the claimant at frequent intervals

And in all these years he has complained
of weakness in his back and in my judgment
unable to perform manual labor

I further declare that I have no interest in said case, and am not concerned in
its prosecution.
