



The name of organizations in which you served? Answer. Private and Sergeant in Co. D, 7 Regt. Md. C. S. Volunteers

No. 2. What was your post office at enlistment? Answer. Royal Oak, Talbot Co., Md.

No. 3. State your wife's full name and her maiden name. Answer. Emma J. Johnson, Emma Johnson

No. 4. When, where, and by whom were you married? Answer. May 4, 1913, Baltimore, Md. by Rev. John A. Holmes

No. 5. Is there any official or church record of your marriage? Answer. yes

If so, where? Answer. Court House and Metropolitan, No. 5 Church

No. 6. Were you previously married? If so, state the name of your former wife, the date of the marriage, and the date and place of her death or divorce. If there was more than one previous marriage, let your answer include all former wives. Answer. yes.
