In reply to the inclosed called of the 24th inst would say.

After my discharge in 1866 I resided on Morris ally bet Ross and Preston lived there 2 years in 1868 removed to Preston St near Druid Hill av, removed in 1869 Bolton ally near Hoffman St, in 1871 Oxford St near Pennsylvania av, in 1875 Moor ally between Tessier + Druid Hill av in 1888 to 610 Sterling St where I now reside, all the above in Balto City Md. while in line of duty at Benedict Charles Co. Md. Jan 1864 I was carrying poles for the purpose of building log houses, my mate dropped his end without giving me notice injuring my back, and whilst in line of duty at Fort Sumner Va Sept-1864 was taken prisoner by the enemy sent to Libby prison Va, whilst so confined was compelled by force to assist in building breast works for the Enemy, from the severe strain, my back which was weak
