

DECLARATION FOR INCREASE OF PENSION AND NEW DISABILITY,
Under Acts of June 27, 1890, May 9, 1900, and Order of March 15, 1904.

Act Feb 6 1907

State of MARYLAND, County of BALTIMORE, ss:

ON THIS 12th day of February, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and seven personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, Nathan Johnson, aged 64 1/2 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore, County of Maryland, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States enrolled at the Washington D.C. Pension Agency, at the rate of Six dollars per month, Certificate No. 564,793, by reason of disability from Here name the disability for which pension was granted.

That he was a private & Sergt in Co. D. 7, Regt. M.S.C. Inf Vols. having enlisted on the 26th September 1863 and honorably discharged on November 16 1866.

That he has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he did not serve prior to Sept 26 1863 nor since November 16 1866

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of Age Here state the reasons for applying for increase. If on account of increase in the disability for which already pensioned, that should be described.

And he also believes himself to be entitled to a further increase of pension on account of the following disabilities for which he has not heretofore been pensioned. Prays benefit Under Act February 6 1907. If either of these new disabilities are the result of an injury, or accident, state where, when and how they were incurred.

Also by reason of infirmities of age, being born on the 22nd day of February, 1842 and applies for a rating under the order of the Commissioner of Pensions of March 15, 1904.

That said disabilities are not the result of his vicious habits and are to the best of his knowledge permanent in character; that he appoints

David L. Stamm, of 528 W. Franklin St. Baltimore Md his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim.
