Q Who will know you injured your back as stated herein?

A My witnesses Jacob Cooper & John Allen are dead. I know of no others, unless my brother knows of it. No I cant say that he will. No, I cant remember of ever telling him of my injury. Yes I complained of my back at Camp Bendick, in Libby & Bull Pen Prisons & in service while the regt was ~~at~~ in Texas, but cant give names of persons who will know of it but think most any of the boys in the Co, or who were prisoners will know of it. I know my Bunk & mess mates are all dead but my brother Isaac Johnson. Of the list of Comrades I know them all, but cant say if any of them were in prison with me, some of them probably was. My brother is my only Comrade here. Since the war I have lived in this city. The first work done by me was handling grain in & about the different ware houses this city, I went to
