Johnson, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer
truly all interrogatories propounded to him during this Special Examination of afore-
said pension claim, deposes and says: *I am 54 years of age,*

a local preacher of the M. E. Church, reside
and my City address is 439 Orchard St,
Baltimore Md,

I am the identical person who is
pensioned under the above Act, at \$6
per month for injury of back, my pension
is under the new Law, this claim
was filed by G. W. Vernon.

I now seek pension under the general
Law on account same disability for
which I now receive Pension.

I was in the U. S. Army, I enlisted
at Camp Belger Balto, Md, Sept, 1863
and was discharge at Texas and
mustered out of Service at Ft Federal
Hill Baltimore Md, in the winter of 1866.

No. I was never in any other Military
organization and was not in the Navy.

I was the only Nathan Johnson in the
Co. ~~#~~ "D" 7th U. S. C. T., there were
several Johnsons in the Co, but I
cant recall the front names of any
of them except Isaac, Josiah, John,
Lewis & Thomas, Johnson. The first named
is my brother, no, none of the others
were related to me.
