

A Declaration for Original Invalid Pension. A

TO BE EXECUTED BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR SOME OFFICER THEREOF HAVING CUSTODY OF THE CLERK'S SEAL. Should this Declaration be executed before a Notary Public, Justice of the Peace or Police Magistrate it will be worthless.

State of Maryland County of Baltimore, ss.

ON THIS 3 day of July A. D., one thousand eight hundred and 80, personally appeared before me Deputy Clerk of Circuit Court No 2 Charles Bennett aged 50 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore, County of Baltimore State of Md., who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is

the identical Charles Bennett who was ENROLLED on the 27 day of Sept 1863, in Company E of the 7 Regiment of U.S. Troops commanded by Capt Spaulding and was honorably DISCHARGED at Indiana La Paz on the 13 day of October, 1866; that

his personal description is as follows: Age 50 years; height 5 feet 6 inches; complexion dark; hair black; eyes black. That while a member of the organization,

aforsaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Benedict, in the State of Maryland on or about the Month of January, 1864.

he Contracted Mumps from exposure he Contracted Cold and from the same Resulted in piles,
Here state name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its causes; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.

And whilst in Jacksonville Florida in the Summer of 1864 - whilst with his Regiment and in line of duty whilst on the retreat Injured his right leg double quicking and in hard marching

That he was treated in hospitals as follows, in Benedict Charles Co Md
Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and the dates of treatment.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above....

Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been that of a laborer.

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a farmer. That he is now much disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, A. B. WEBB, of Washington, D. C.; his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim.

That he has not received no applied for a Pension. That his Post-Office address is No 207 No. Wolfst Bldg County of Balto State of Md.
