

DECLARATION FOR PENSION

ACT OF MAY 1, 1920

The Pension Certificate Should Not Be Forwarded With the Application

State of Maryland County of Baltimore ss:

On this 10th day of Sept 1920, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Mathias Price, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 81 years of age, and a resident of Baltimore City county of Maryland; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Maryland, under the name of Mathias Price on the 22nd day of November 1863 as a private in Co 2 9th Reg U.S. Colored Vol (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) in the service of the United States, in the Civil war (State name of war, Civil or Mexican.) war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Hicks Gin Height, Balto Md. 18 on the 4 day of Jan 1866. That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height.....feet.....inches; complexion black color of eyes gray; color of hair dark; that his occupation was Farming; that he was born 27th Nov 18do not remember year, at Maryland.

That he requires the regular personal aid and attendance of another person on account of the following disabilities: enclosed doctors certificate (State in this space the nature of any and all disabilities.)

That since leaving the service he has resided at Balto Md and his occupation has been none. That he has.....applied for pension under original No..... That he is a pensioner under Certificate No. 80880.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of May 1, 1920.

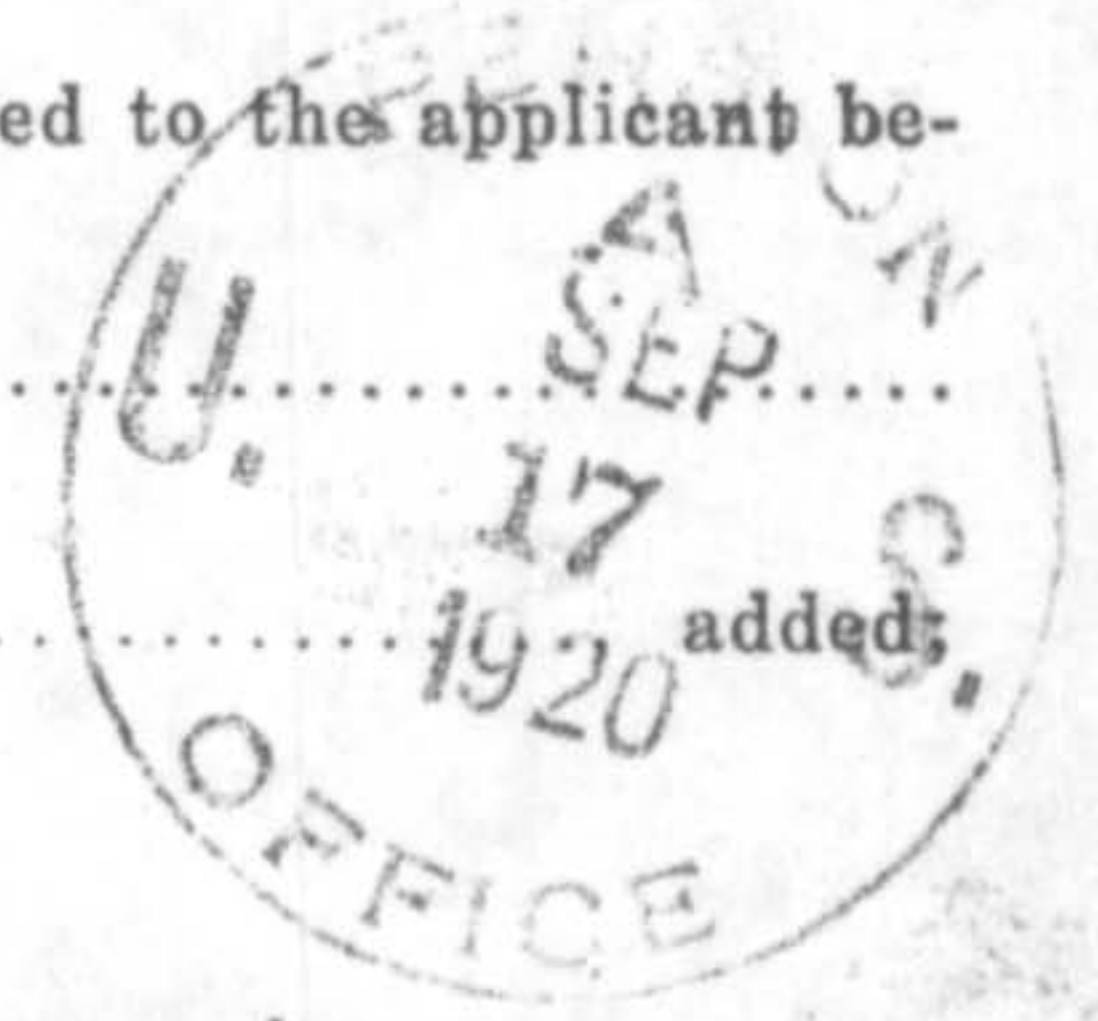
