# DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

Act of May 1, 1920.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

STATE OF Baltimore, COUNTY OF Md., ss:  
 On this 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, A. D. 1921, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace  
Citizen, within and for the county and State aforesaid, Baltimore Maryland  
 who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 77 years of age, and a resident of Baltimore City  
 county of Baltimore, State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person  
 who was ENROLLED at Talbot County, under the name of Mathias Price  
 on the 22 day of November, 1863, as a Part  
 in Co. 99<sup>th</sup> Regiment U.S. Colored Infantry  
 (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the Civil War, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED  
 at Hicks General Hospital, on the 10 day of January, 1866 That he also  
 served by wounds received in battle

That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, Not Known feet — inches; complexion, Black  
 color of eyes, Black; color of hair, Black; that his occupation was —

That he requires the regular personal aid and attendance of another person on account of the following disabilities:  
I suffer with Paraplegia and Rheumatism  
 (State in this space the nature of any and all disabilities.)

I am Physical Disable and Partly blind cannot see  
enough to walk alone and Requires the personal aid  
and attendances of my Daughter at all times

That since leaving the service he has resided at Baltimore Md

and his occupation has been None.

That he has Now applied for pension under Original No. 80880 That he is Now a pensioner under Certificate  
 No. 80880 That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the  
 provisions of the act of May 1, 1920.
