My dear Mr. Coady:-

Relative to the claim for increase under section 2, act of May 1, 1920, filed in the above cited case September 17, 1920, I have the honor to inform you that a medical examination is not warranted as the evidence on file does not show that claimant requires the regular personal aid and attendance of another person.

The claim is therefore held in abeyance and if at any time claimant should file additional evidence tending to show that by reason of age and physical or mental disabilities he has become helpless or blind, or so nearly helpless or blind, as to require the regular personal aid and attendance of another person, the claim will be given further consideration.
