well known to me to be reputable and entitled to credit, and who, being duly sworn, declared in relation to aforesaid case

as follows: I am the identical Shadrack Boulton who served as a private in Co "H" 19th Regt colored troops and well knew Henry Johnson of Co "H" of said Regt.

I further recollect that while the Regiment was a Camp Benedict Md about February or March 1864—the Johnson among others was detailed to carry logs and heavy timber for officers quarters and fuel and while so engaged was injured in the spine of the back by a log falling on him—and thereafter his health seemed to be in a general decline—
