

up to within the fall previous
 to his death, he continued to work
 at shucking - The first two years
 that he was working at shucking
 he worked in another building
 away from me, but after that
 he worked in the same shucking
 house with me, I used to earn from
 70 to 150 cents a week - while we were working
 together I don't know what he
 earned. - I don't know whether he
 lost any time from his employment
 there, but he always complained
 of his cough and back pain
 He quit work or was taken sick
 during the summer and the following
 fall when he was to work
 his cough followed him up
 until he died - I don't know the cause
 of his death. Saw the doctor there
 at his house once during his last
 sickness but don't know his name
 I don't live near Cleveland but I have
 never heard that she has remarried
 or living with any man since her
 husband's death
