

Declaration for Pension,

ACT OF FEBRUARY 6 1907

State of Maryland County of Queen Anne's, ss:

ON THIS 9 day of March, A. D., one thousand nine hundred and 7 personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, James Taylor, aged 64 years, a resident of Centurth, County of Queen Anne's State of Maryland, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the _____ Pension Agency at the rate of 10.00 dollars per month, under certificate No. 887349, by reason of partial inability to earn a support by manual labor. That he served ninety days during the War of the Rebellion, was honorably discharged.

That he served in the military service of the United States, as a Private of Co. K 39 Regiment of U.S.C.T. Volunteers; That he was born on the _____ day of April 1848

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the Pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the ACT. of Feb. 6 1907.

That he hereby constitutes and appoints

his true and lawful attorneys to prosecute this claim.
