

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

This may be executed before any officer authorized by law to administer oaths for general purposes. If executed before an Officer who has a seal, certificate of Clerk of Court showing official character is not necessary. Otherwise certificate of Clerk of Court should be attached to declaration.

personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace

within and for the county and State aforesaid, James Taylor aged 48 years, a

resident of town county of Centerville State of Maryland

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical James Taylor

who was Enrolled on the 31 day of March 1864 in Co. K.

39th Reg. U.S.C.I. "Private" (Here state rank, company and regi- ment in the Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.)

in the War of the Rebellion and served at

least ninety days, and was Honorably Discharged at Wilmington N.C.

on the 4 day of Dec 1865

That he is partly unable to earn a support by reason of (Here name the diseases or injuries from which disabled.)

Stroke while in service & Rheumatism in feet & legs

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent.

That he has applied for pension under application No. That he is

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints
