In the matter of Pension claim of James Taylor

Personally came before me, a justice of the peace in and for aforesaid  
County and State, Chas. A. Wilson, aged 53 years,  
a citizen of the town of Centerville, County of Queen Anne's,  
State of Md., well known to me to be reputable and entitled to credit, and

who, being duly sworn, declares in relation to the aforesaid case, as follows:

The claimant and I enlisted at the same  
and were enrolled in Co K. 39. Reg U.S.C.T  
whilst at or near the Pamunkey River Va  
whilst on a march the claimant was Sun Struck  
and about one month later he was taken  
with the mumps & rupture whilst on those  
heavy marches ground that part of Va.  
which was in the summer of 1864 during  
that fall he was attacked with rheumatism  
and has been affected with those disabilities ever since  
being of his bed ridden for a month at a time. He is a  
great sufferer from rheumatism & rupture. He cannot  
do hard work. He now is not able to do more  
than 1/3 manual work. I have lived within three miles of  
him ever since our discharge

I further declare that I have no interest in said case and am not concerned in its prosecution.
