as appears by the Record of Marriages in the Clerk's office of the Court of Common Pleas,

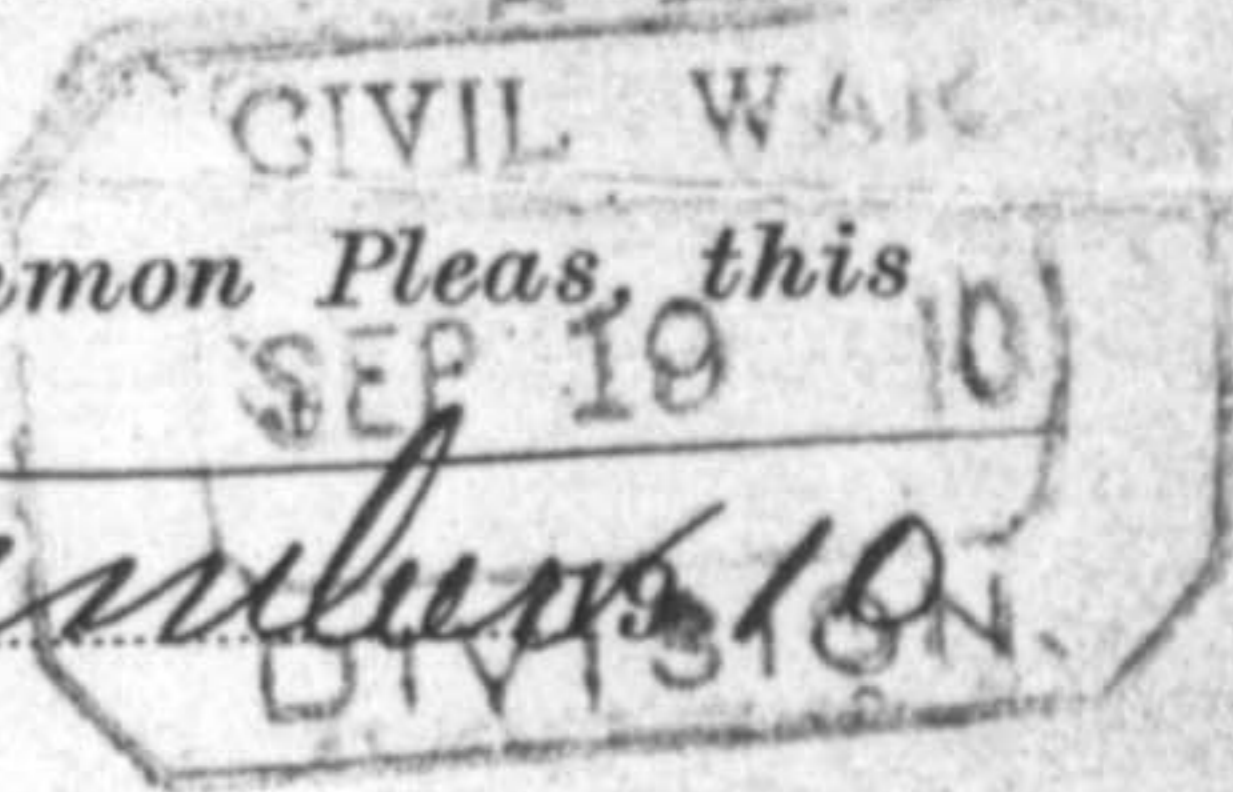
