I certify that I have examined Josiah Keensley late a private of Co B. 7th Regiment U S C Infantry and find the following condition. Deafness disease of the eardrums. Severe deafness of both ears, inability to hear loud conversation beyond 3 feet. Has a sero-purulent discharge from the ears.

Eyes pupils slowly responds to light, has arcus Senilis Cannot count fingers beyond 10 feet.

Marked tenderness over lumbar muscles with pain on stooping. Cannot get to floor without bending. The knees walk with a stoop. Does not know his age. Looks to be old. Has pain in left hip joint on movement, and right wrist joint.

Heart beats rapid and diffused. Pulse 96. bounding mitral valve gives a slight systolic murmur. Has shortness of breath on exertion.

In my opinion claimant is not able to perform manual labor to earn a support. I have no interest in claimant getting a pension given under my hand and dictation
