State of Maryland, Baltimore City, to wit:

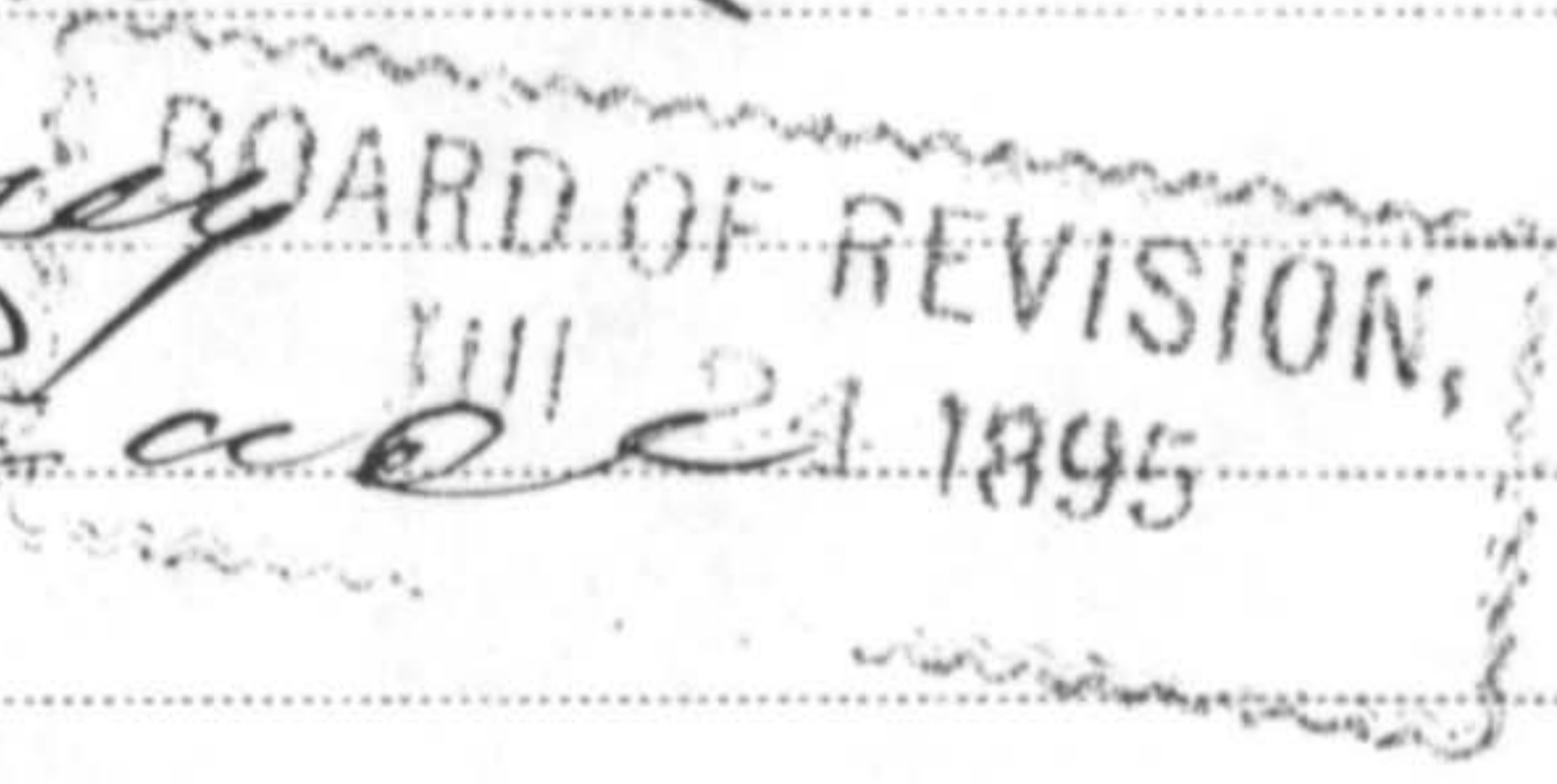
