

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

State of MARYLAND, County of BALTIMORE ss:

On the 13th day of January, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and nine personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and state aforesaid Rebecca Hensley, aged 65 years, a resident of Baltimore City, County of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain pension under the provisions of the Act of Congress Approved, April 19, 1908.

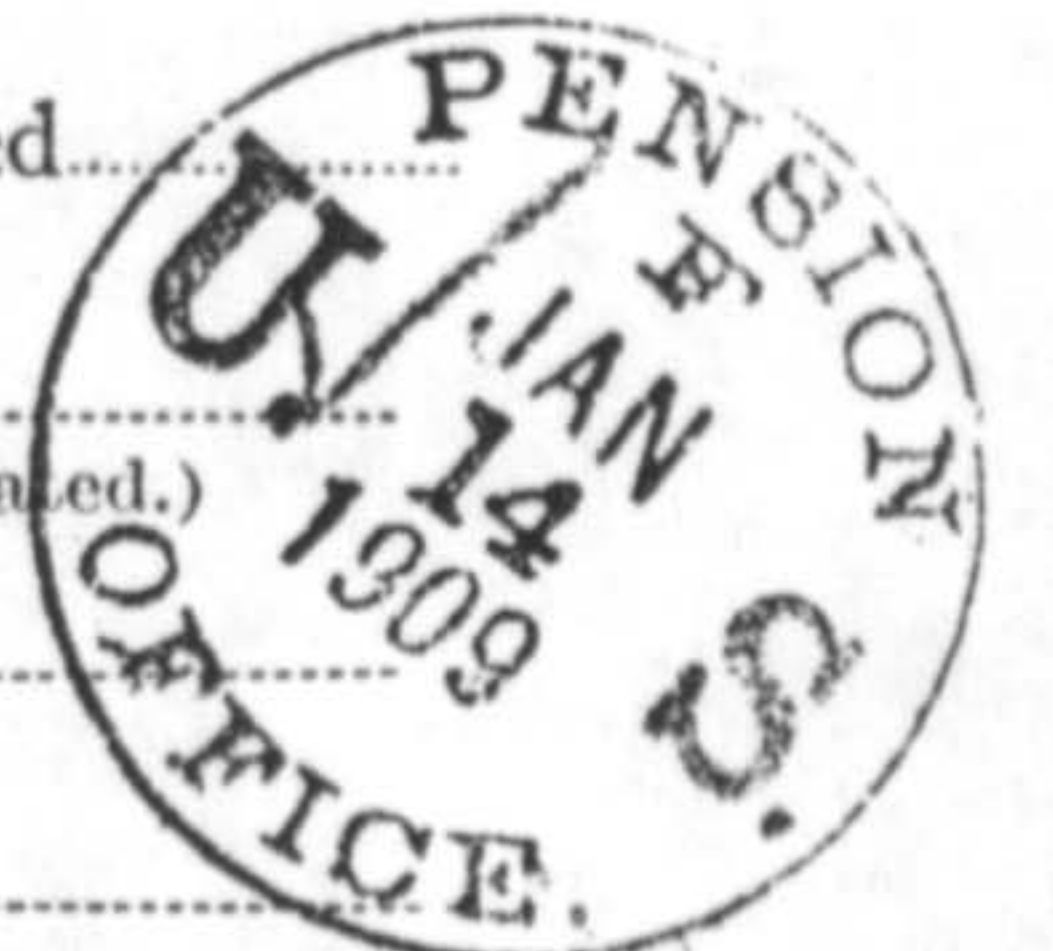
That she is the widow of Isaac Hensley, who was enrolled under the name of Isaac Hensley, at on the 23rd day of September, 1863, as a private in Co. "B," 7th Regiment U.S.C. Infantry, and honorably discharged October 13th, 1866, having served ninety days or more during the late civil war.

That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services if any.)

That he was not in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above.

That she was married under the name of Rebecca Fisher to said soldier at Baltimore City Md on the 12th day of December, 1867, by Rev Amos Hutton; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage; that she had not been previously married; that the soldier had not been previously married.

(If there was a prior marriage of either, the date and place of death or divorce of former consort or consorts should be stated.)



and that neither she nor said soldier married otherwise than is stated above.

That the said soldier died January 6th, 1909, at Baltimore City Md, that she was not divorced from him, and that she has not remarried since his death.

That the said soldier left the following-named children who are now living and under sixteen years of age, to wit: (If the soldier left no children, the claimant should so state.)

That she has not heretofore applied for pension Her deceased husband was a pensioner under Act of June 27, 1890, Certificate No 609,254 service on which it was based, and the name of the soldier should be stated.)

She hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation David D. Stanton, 528 W. Franklin Street of Baltimore, State of Maryland her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, and to receive therefor a fee of \$10.
