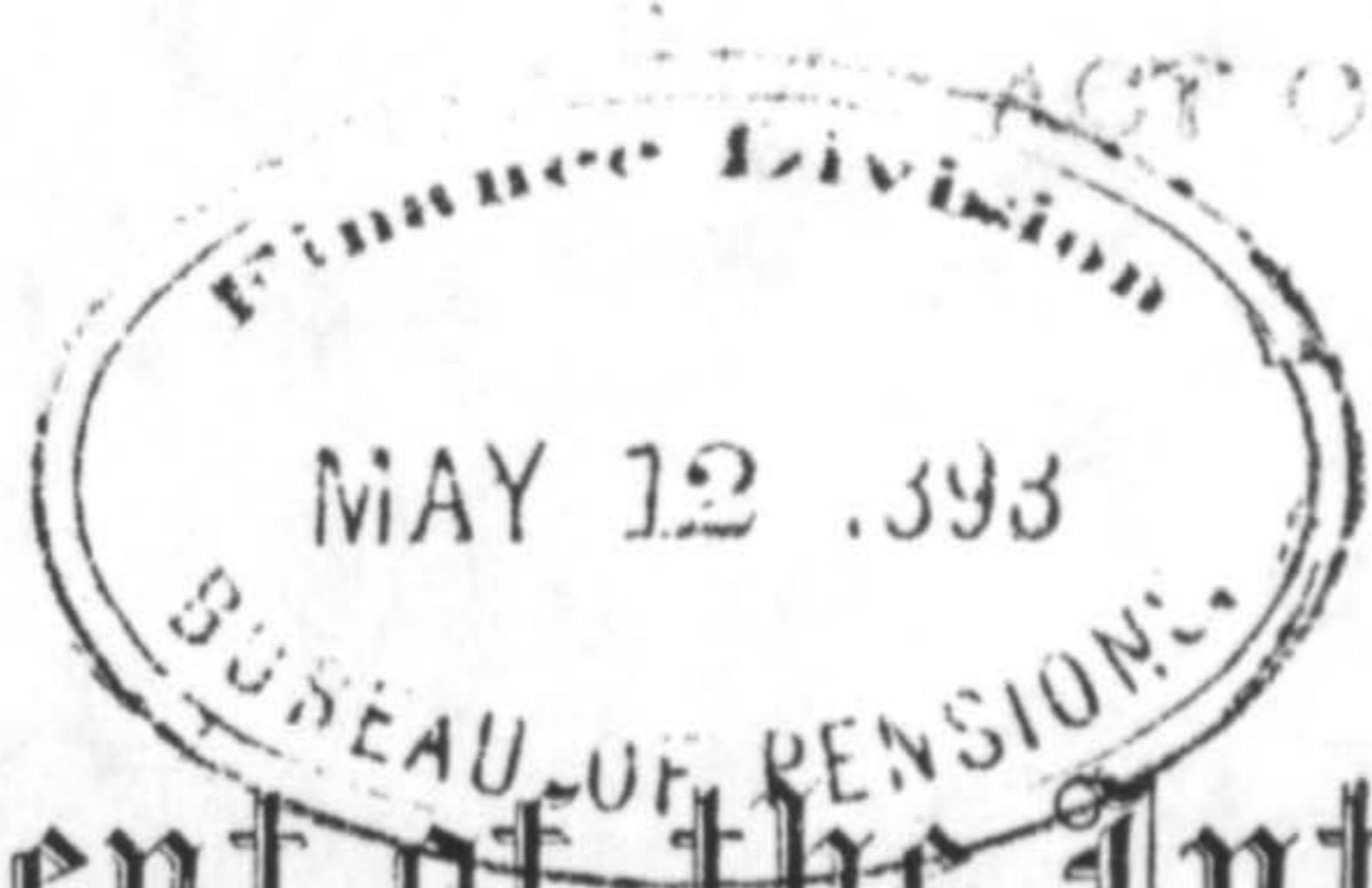

Answer. At home in my own residence.

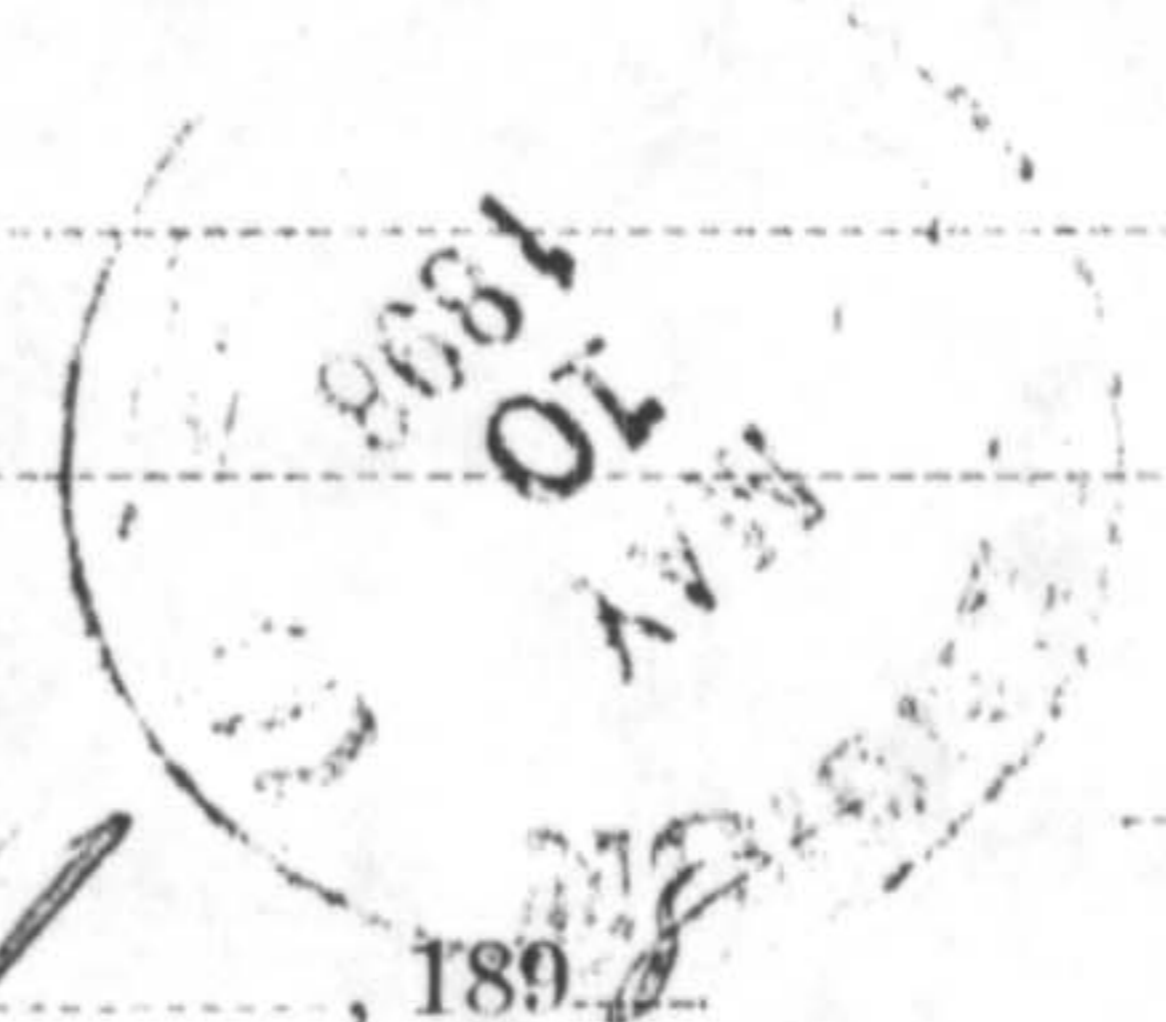
Fourth. Were you previously married? If so, please state the name of your former wife and the date and place of her death or divorce.
