BE IT REMEMBERED, That on this 21 day of January

A. D. 1909, before me, the subscriber a Justice of the Peace, George Cooper,

of the said State, in and for the City aforesaid, personally appeared

W.O.N. 9/1589 of Rebecca Hensley, widow of Isaiah Hensley, Co's 63, 7th M.S.C. Ind. Vt.

and made oath in due form of law that the deceased soldier and I were

Boys together, raised together. Both Slaves, Both
enlisted together in same Company and regiments.
Knew him before he became of marriageable age
I know of my own personal knowledge, that he was
not married prior to his marriage to Rebecca Fisher,
Knew her from her childhood, know she was not
married prior to her marriage to the late Isaiah
Hensley, in 1867. I was married the same year.
I know of my own personal knowledge that the
Claimant and Soldier, were not divorced, but lived
together as man and wife from the date of their marriage,
till the death of the Soldier, who died leaving no minor
child, or children, under the age of sixteen years,
and further testify that the Claimant has not remarried
since the death of the Soldier.

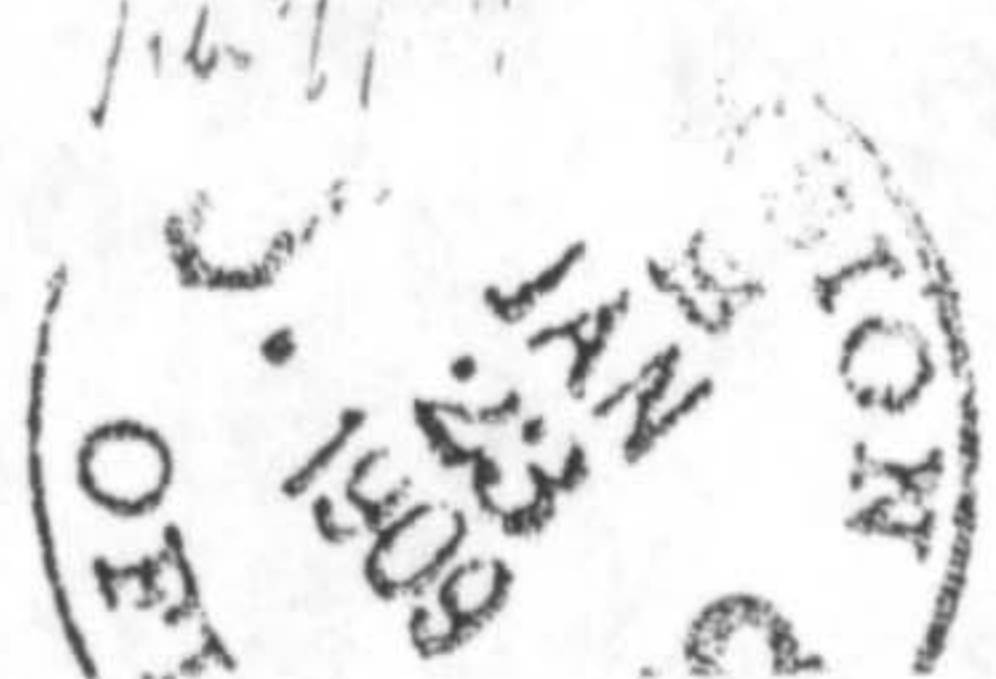
I further testify that the Soldier
