His present physical condition is no way due to vicious habits he is and has been during my knowledge of him a man of excellent habits, and he is perfectly reliable. He is not inclined to be lazy - has always been a cheerful worker when able.

He is a poor man and has no means of support except a small pension which is allowed him by the U. S. Govt. and what aid is given him by his wife.
