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while he worked for them,

Q Do you know of his being troubled with disease of stomach since the war,

A I do not,

Q Did you ever know him to be confined to the house with any sickness since the war except winter before last,

A I have known him to have some short spells, but don't know what was the matter with him,

Q Do you know whether he was physically disqualified for purposes of Manual Labour to any extent during the first seven years after discharge, if so to what extent,

A I can't say to what extent he was disabled, but I heard him complain of being unwell during that time,

Q Was he not as competent a Coachman when he drove for Thomas Lonsdale, as when he drove for M^{rs} Alexander Brown

A I don't know,

Q Are you the David L. Decoursey who has heretofore testified in behalf of James Henson, in his claim for a pension

A I am,

Q Are you directly or indirectly interested in the claim of James Henson for a pension

A I am not
