

# Declaration for Widow's Pension.

Act of June 27, 1890, as Amended by Act of May 9, 1900.

State of MARYLAND, <sup>CITY</sup> ~~County~~ of BALTIMORE, SS:

ON this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and Six <sup>City</sup> personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the County and State aforesaid, Sarah Tilghman, aged 59 years, a resident of Baltimore, County of \_\_\_\_\_, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain pension under the provisions of the ACT OF CONGRESS APPROVED JUNE 27, 1890, AS AMENDED BY THE ACT OF MAY 9, 1900:

That she is the widow of Charles N. Tilghman who was enlisted under the name of Charles N. Tilghman at Baltimore Md on the 28 day of June, 1868 as a private in Co B 7<sup>th</sup> U.S. C<sup>T</sup> Here state rank and designation of organization or name of vessel and honorably discharged \_\_\_\_\_ 18\_\_\_\_\_, having served ninety days or more during the late war of the rebellion. That the soldier was not in the MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE of the United States except as stated above.

If any other service it should be stated in full

That she was married under the name of Sarah Morr to said soldier at Baltimore Md on the 28 day of June, 1868 by Rev Hutton; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage; that she had not been previously married; that the soldier had not been previously married. If there was a prior marriage of either, the date and place of death or divorce of former consort or consorts should be stated

That the said soldier died January 12 1906 at Baltimore Md; that she was not divorced from him; that she has not remarried since his death; and that she is without other means of support than her daily labor and an actual net income not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars per year.

That the NAMES AND DATES OF BIRTH of all the children of the soldier, now living, and under SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE at the date of the soldier's death, are as follows: (If the soldier left no children, the claimant should so state.)

That she hereby appoints A. PARLETT LLOYD, If she desires to employ an attorney

of BALTIMORE, MD. her true and lawful attorney, to prosecute this claim,
