On this day and date below written, personally appeared the affiant whose signature is hereto affixed and who being duly sworn according to law testified as follows:

"My name is Sarah Tilghman. I am 57 years old, and I reside in Baltimore, Md. at No. 507 Oxford Street.

I am the claimant in this case. I was never married before I married Charles H. Tilghman and he was not previously married. We were never divorced but lived together until his death separated us. I have not remarried since he died and have owned no property real personal or mixed and he left none of any kind but I have been and am still wholly dependent upon my own daily labor for support. No one has been bound to support me since my husband died. His life was not insured but the Galilean Fisherman will pay \$50 towards the funeral expense. This is the only money that will be paid on account of his death. I ask waiver of Tax Collector's affidavit for reason the evidence I will file will show no property. I find that the date of my marriage on my original marriage certificate was 18th June 1868. I may have given 28th from memory 18th is correct. Rev Henry Hutton who performed our marriage ceremony is dead and I cannot trace his record. He was just a local preacher & not pastor of any particular church at the time.

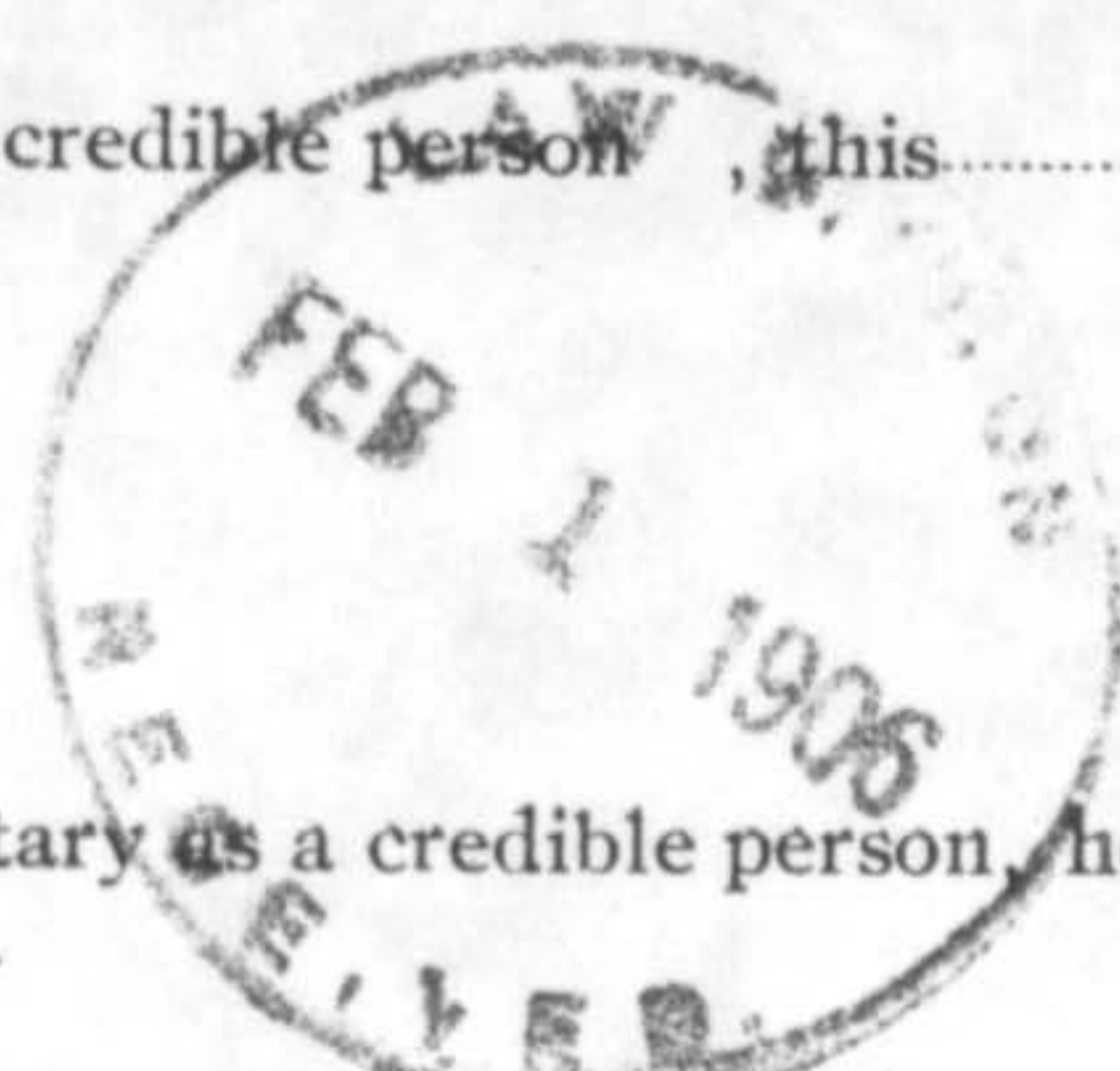

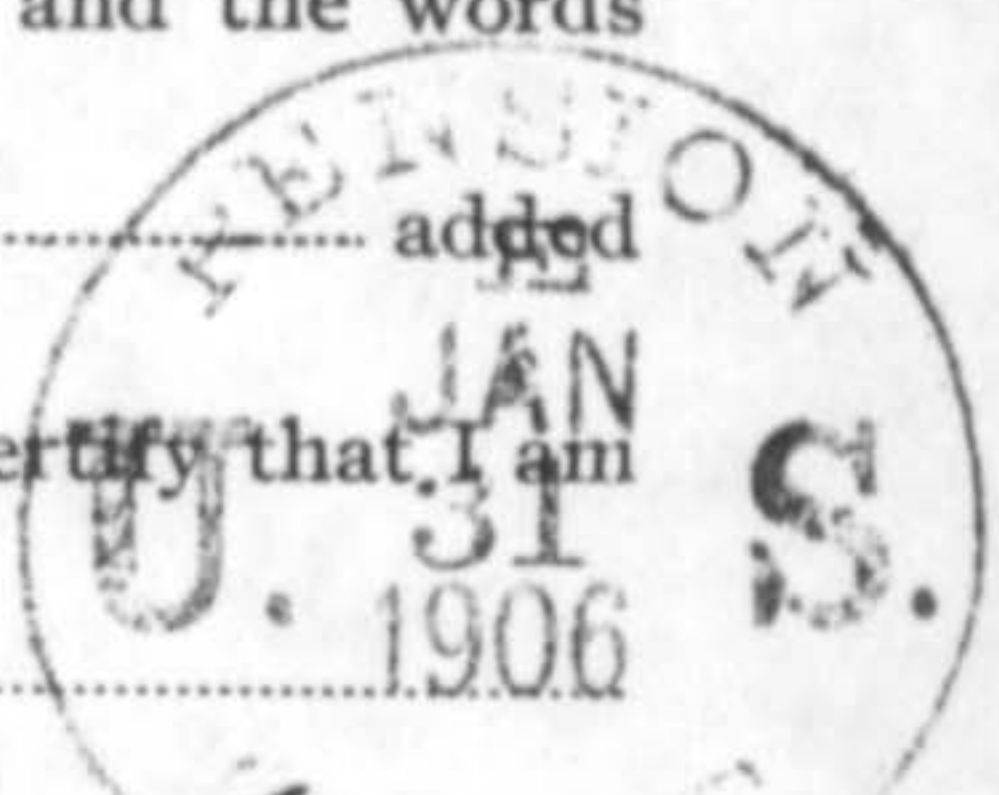
