I was present at the time. They lived together as man and wife till he died, here in this house in June, some 6 or 7 years ago. I could not say what was the cause of death.

Bates was Fannie's first husband. Gibson's first wife died long before he married Fannie. Thomas Tolbot, is the only person I know that knew anything about Bates and when he came from Va. He is off sailing and I don't know when he will get back.

I think Joe Lewis brought Bates into this neighborhood.

Affidavit No 3 in B. J. is mine. No. I do not know Bates had a living wife when he married my sister. We understood at that time that he was a single man.
