(ten (\$10.) dollars as prescribed by Law.

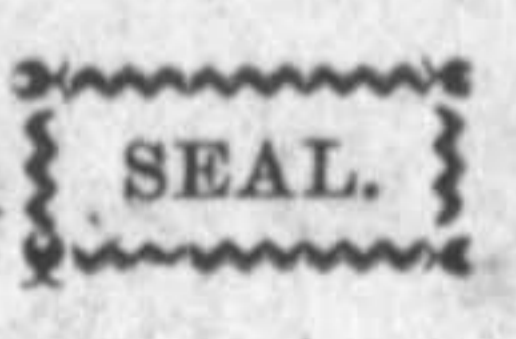


and to, from time to time, furnish any further evidence necessary or that may be demanded,
